Group 1: Mentor Members

4 members required

Strategies:

G1.D2 Capitalize on the expertise of others, including engaging life members as mentors.

G3.A4 Focus on inter-generational skills mentorship.

Objectives: Increase capacity and efficiency of leadership and increase participation of diverse cultural and generational groups.

This working group will:

- Research mentorship and successful organizations (faith and non-faith based) that use mentors.
- Create a skills bank of interested members (including but not limited to life members and existing national, provincial, regional (if applicable), and diocesan executive members).
- Make recommendations to the national executive/board on continuing data collection and compilation methods.

Time Commitment: April 2022-April 2023. Approximately four to eight hours monthly and teleconference calls as required.

Group 2: Education on Core Purpose**3 members required****Strategy:****G4.A2** Educate members on the core purpose of the League.**Objective:** Validate options in structure and meetings.

This working group will develop a resource to provide understanding on why the League's core purpose of "uniting Catholic women to grow in faith, and to promote social justice through service to the church, Canada and the world" is fundamental in achieving the envisioned future.

Members of this group will enjoy working independently, researching internal and external resources, and collaboratively with other working group members.

Time Commitment: April 2022-February 2023. Approximately three to five hours weekly and teleconference calls as required.**Group 3: Collaboration with Faith Organizations****4 members required****Strategies:****G2.C1** Identify specific faith organizations with similar purpose, core values and missions.**G2.C2** Clarify the manner that collaboration will take place with other faith organizations.**Objective:** Increase collaboration with faith organizations and governments.

This working group will identify ecumenical and interfaith organizations with whom it can collaborate on issues that resonate with the core values, purpose and mission of the League. The group will generate a list of contact names, the organization, core values and any additional information.

Questions will be prepared and used for the annual reports to identify the current level of engagement by councils in ecumenical and interfaith endeavours. The group will identify the myriad of ways members can work together with organizations to collaborate.

All groups work collaboratively, so members must also be comfortable in this setting.

Time Commitment: April 2022-April 2023 for completion of this strategy. Approximately two to four hours weekly and teleconference calls as required.

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
